- (a) & (b). No, Madam. There is no such proposal with University Grants Commission (UGC) to further amend regulations regarding Academic Performance Indicators (API). The last amendments to APIs was effected through the notification of the 4th Amendment to the UGC (Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education), Regulations, 2016 dated 11th July, 2016.
- (c) & (d) No, Madam. API scores are mandatory qualifying benchmarks for Career Advancement Scheme and for direct recruitment of teachers and other academic staff in Universities and Colleges.
