Quality of School Uniforms

3124. SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE:

Will the **Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it has been brought to the notice of the Government that the students of Government schools in the country have not been provided schools uniforms of good quality;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): The Central Government through its flagship programme of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) supports the States and UTs for universalization of elementary education across the country. The SSA norms provide for 2 Sets of uniforms to children from the deprived community viz. all girls, SC, ST and BPL boys, @ Rs. 400 per head.

The issues pertaining to the design, style and procurement of uniforms come under the domain of the States and UTs. The SSA framework further prescribes that procurement for school uniforms has to be decentralized and is to be done at the School Management Committee (SMC) level. Accordingly, complaints on the issue are forwarded to the respective State Governments and UT Administrations.
