(a) and (b) The Ministry is primarily responsible for development and maintenance of National Highways (NHs). The development and maintenance of NHs is a continuous process. Various works on NHs are taken up as per the Ministry's specifications, extant policies, relevant codes of Indian Roads Congress updated from time to time. Accordingly, the NHs including those damaged due to rains are kept in traffic worthy condition from time to time within the available resources based upon the assessment of their conditions, traffic density and inter-se priority.

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
