(a) to (e): The IIT-Council in its 50th Meeting held on 23.08.2016 approved inprinciple, the project Vishwajeet which proposed specific interventions for strengthening the 7 IITs namely, IIT-Kharagpur, IIT-Delhi, IIT-Bombay, IIT-Kanpur, IIT-Madras, IIT-Roorkee and IIT-Guwahati to help them to come up into the Top 100 World University Rankings. The concerned IITs have been asked to prepare a plan of action for implementing the Scheme.
