Schemes for Youth

319. SHRI GAJENDRA SINGH SHEKHAWAT:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of schemes/programmes being implemented by the Government for youth in the country particularly in rural areas;
- (b) whether the Government is aware that the rural youth has lesser access to information, career opportunities and training facilities and thus lags behind the urban youth; and
- (c) if so, the steps taken by the Government to address these issues?

(a) to (c) : The Ministry is implementing various schemes/programmes for promotion of youth development in the country as under: -

1. Rashtriya Yuva Sashaktikaran Karyakram (RYSK):

The Scheme has following components: -

- i) Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS)
- ii) National Youth Corps (NYC)
- iii) National Programme for Youth and Adolescent Development (NPYAD)
- iv) International Cooperation (IC)
- v) Youth Hostel (YH)
- vi) Assistance to Scouting and Guiding Organisations
- vii) National Young Leaders Programme (NYLP)
- viii) National Discipline Scheme Instructors (NDSI)

2. National Service Scheme (NSS)

3. Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Youth Development (RGNIYD)

Initiatives under above schemes/programmes are designed to enhance information and sensitization of the youth including rural youth and to contribute to their personality development through leadership training.
