Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether incidents of killing of innocent tribals by the Naxalites have been reported;
- (b) if so, the details of such cases reported and the action taken thereon during each of the last three years and the current year, State-wise;
- (c) whether any campaign is being run with the tribals to eliminate naxalism;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the other measures being taken in this regard?

'Police' and Public Order', being State subjects, maintenance of Law and Order is the primary responsibility of the State Government concerned. However, Central Government supplements efforts of the States to address LWE menace through a multi-pronged strategy to tackle Left Wing Extremism in the country consisting of security related measures; development related interventions; ensuring rights and entitlements of local communities etc. On developmental side, the Central Government has also supplemented the actions of the States Governments and taken various measures including construction of roads, strengthening of communications network, installation of mobile towers, improving network of banks, post offices, health and education facilities in LWE areas.
