Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of files operating in Interpol regarding culprits of India residing abroad or doing business from there or those absconding abroad; and
- (b) the number of culprits apprehended or handed over to India by Interpol during the last three years?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI HANSRAJ GANGARAM AHIR)

- (a): As on 02.12.2016 712 Red Notices and 118 Blue Notices have been issued by INTERPOL on the request of various Law Enforcement Agencies of India for locating and/or arresting various culprits of India.
- (b): INTERPOL does not apprehend culprits but facilitates in locating fugitives. Hence, question of handing over culprits to India by INTERPOL does not arise.
