RECRUITMENT BY TERRORISTS

3336. . DR. C. GOPALAKRISHNAN:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government is aware that terror recruitments are increasing along the porous international border particularly Indo-Bangladesh border;

(b) if so, the details of action taken to curb terror recruitment activities;

(c) whether any awareness camp has been conducted or there is any proposal to conduct such camps all over the country; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI HANSRAJ GANGARAM AHIR)

(a) to (d) : No specific information of increase in terror recruitments along the international borders, particularly Indo-Bangladesh border, has been received. However, in order to counter terror activities, there exists close and effective coordination between intelligence and security agencies at the Centre and the States level. Various programmes are being undertaken by the Central and State Governments to deal with the issues of counter terrorism and counter radicalization. However, further details cannot be disclosed in the interest of the national security.
