**Revival of PSEs**

Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES & PUBLIC ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has any proposal to bail out the loss making Public Sector Enterprises (PSEs) or prepared any blue print to deal with sick/loss making PSEs in the country;

(b) if so, the details thereof, PSE-wise; and

(c) the steps taken so far by the Government in this regard?

**ANSWER**

(a) & (b): Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) function under the administrative control of various Ministries/Departments and all matters relating to revival/restructuring/closure of CPSEs are dealt by the concerned administrative Ministries/Departments.

(c): Department of Public Enterprises (DPE), as a nodal department, has issued guidelines on 29.10.2015 for “Streamlining the mechanism for revival and restructuring of sick/ incipient sick and weak Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs)”. As per the guidelines, the concerned administrative Ministries/ Departments are responsible to monitor the performance of the CPSEs and categorise them as sick/ incipient sick/ weak CPSEs. The concerned administrative Ministries/ Departments are also responsible for formulating revival/restructuring/ disinvestment/closure plans for CPSEs functioning under them and after obtaining the approval of competent authority, implement the plans.
