- (a) whether upgradation of existing 500 Government Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) is States/UTs has been taken up under the World Bank assisted Vocational Training Improvement Project (VTIP);
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of the VTIP implemented in the ITIs in various States including Odisha?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT & ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI RAJIV PRATAP RUDY)

- (a) to (b) The World Bank assisted Vocational Training Improvement Project (VTIP), interalia envisages upgradation of 400 Government Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) in 34 States /Union Territories (UTs). The funding pattern between center and state is 75:25 (90:10 for NE States). The project started in Dec. 2007 and its closing date is September 2018. Total fund released to States/UTs is Rs. 1633 crore so far.
- (c) The State/ UT wise details of number of ITIs covered under the project, including Odisha state, are attached as **Annexure I**.
