Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:-
(a) whether the Government proposes to provide financial assistance for attaining financial autonomy to municipalities and if so, the details thereof;
(b) whether most of the earnings of municipalities is spent on providing salaries;
(c) if so, the efforts being made by the Government to arrange funds for development works;
(d) whether the Government proposes to give share in Goods and Service Tax (GST) to municipalities; and
(e) if so, the details thereof?

## ANSWER

## THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (RAO INDERJIT SINGH)

(a): Urban Development is a State subject and Government of India supports the efforts of State Governments by providing financial \& technical assistance through various programmes \& schemes. The Constitution Seventy-Fourth Amendment Act also mandates municipalities with such powers and authority as may be necessary
to enable them to function as institutions of self-government. This includes devolution of powers to municipalities vis-à-vis, functions, functionaries and funds. Further, the Government has accepted the recommendations of 14th Finance Commission for providing Rs. $87,143.80$ crores as grants to municipalities for basic services for the period 2015-2020.
(b)\&(c): In a number of municipalities, a large portion of earning is spent in payments of salaries and wages. Urban Development is a State subject. The Government also supports the efforts of State Governments by providing financial \& technical assistance through its schemes and programmes.
(d)\&(e): No, Madam. There is no such proposal under consideration at present.
