Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether People of Indian Origin (PIOs) have to wait for years for immersing asthi kalash in the holy Ganga river at Haridwar due to non-issue of visa;
- (b) if so, the fact and details thereof;
- (c) whether due to rejection of visa applications by the Indian High Commission in Pakistan more than 100 asthi kalash are waiting for immersion in the holy Ganga; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard?
