This Department monitors the progress of pending cases of prosecution of sanction as submitted by Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) to all Departments/Ministries of Government of India (GOI) through a Committee chaired by Secretary, DOPT and consisting of Secretary of Administrative Department, Law Secretary and CBI. As on 18.11.2016, 11 criminal and corruption cases are pending for granting sanction of prosecution against the officers of All India Service (AIS) and Central Group 'A' officers of the rank of Joint Secretary and above in GOI.
