CCTV CAMERAS IN TRAINS

3596. SHRI NANDI YELLAIAH:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the trains passing through Secunderabad and starting from Secunderabad equipped with surveillance cameras;**
- (b) whether these cameras are installed in every compartment including general unreserved compartments of the above said trains and if so, the details thereof; and**
- (c) the details of additional measures taken to complete the process of installation of CCTV surveillance cameras in trains for which funds are proposed to be derived from the anti-gang rape fund?**

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS

(SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

(a): At present, no trains passing through Secunderabad and starting from Secunderabad are equipped with surveillance cameras.

(b) : Does not arise.

(c) : In order to improve the safety of passengers, the Government has installed Close Circuit Television (CCTV) cameras on a limited number of coaches of passenger and suburban trains on a pilot basis. Sanction for provision of CCTV cameras in 500 coaches has been obtained under the Rolling Stock Programme 2015-16. Work has already been completed in about 25 passenger coaches and 32 suburban coaches that have been commissioned in service. Further proliferation of the system shall be decided based on the results/feedback obtained from these coaches.

Till date, no funds have been used from sources, other than Railways' Budget resources, for the installation of CCTV surveillance cameras in trains.
