CCTVs IN SUBURBAN TRAINS

3611. SHRI NALIN KUMAR KATEEL:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has installed CCTV cameras on coaches of passenger and suburban trains on a pilot basis and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has taken any steps to seek feedback from the train commuters about the implementation of this initiative;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the reaction of the Government in this regard?

(a): Yes, Madam. Sanction for provision of CCTV cameras in 500 coaches has been obtained under the Rolling Stock Programme 2015-16. Work has already been completed in about 25 passenger coaches and 32 suburban coaches that have been commissioned in service.

(b) to (d): No, Madam. Feedback from train passengers has not been sought since it is a provision for improving the Passenger security.
