- (a) & (b): The Central Public Works Department (CPWD), Ministry of Urban Development has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on 25.2.2016 with Stiftelsen SINTEF Institute for Building and Infrastructure, a scientific research organisation situated at Oslo, Norway for human resource development and capacity building in the area of recycling of C&D (Construction & demolition) waste.

(c) & (d): The States & ULBs responsible the activities of building construction are setting up C&D Waste recycling plants as per requirements under the Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules, 2016 published by Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change.
