(a) The erstwhile Planning Commission used to allocate Central Assistance to State Plans (CASP) under different schemes for finalization of Annual Plan of the States. As there is no mandate, this exercise has been discontinued after the existence of NITI Aayog with effect from January 1, 2015. Total fund transfer (plan and non plan) to the States during last three years and budget provision for the current financial year under different heads is as under:
