DELAY IN CONSTRUCTION OF ROBS/RUBS

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether the construction of a large number of manned/ unmanned level crossings, road over bridges and road under bridges has been delayed across the country during the last three years;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, zone-wise and the present status of such crossings/bridges;
- (c) whether the cost of construction of the said crossings/bridges has escalated due to delay in their construction during the said period and if so, the details thereof, zone-wise;
- (d) the number of such crossings/bridges of which cost has been shared by the concerned State or private player alongwith their status, zone-wise; and
- (e) the other steps taken by the Government to ensure timely construction of such crossings/bridges in the country?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (e) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 3658 BY SHRI BHARTRUHARI MAHTAB, DR. SATYAPAL SINGH, SHRI SANJAY DHOTRE AND SHRIMATI KAMLA DEVI PAATLE TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 07.12.2016 REGARDING DELAY IN CONSTRUCTION OF ROBS/RUBS

(a) to (c): No new manned/unmanned level crossings are being constructed in view of safety consideration. Status of achievement of Road Over Bridges/Road Under Bridges during the last three years and in the current year is as under:-

The target being fixed is commensurate with the availability of funds. Funds for Road Safety Works (ROBs/ RUBs/ Subways/ Manned/ Unmanned Level Crossings) come from Central Road Funds (CRF) as a percentage of cess collected on Diesel and Petrol by Ministry of Finance. Due to limited availability of funds and huge throwforward of already sanctioned works, these works are progressing to the extent possible.

Some of other reasons for delay in progress of ROBs are:

- late sanction of corresponding work in the State Budget,
- inadequate fund allocation by the State Government,
- non-availability of encumbrance free land for construction of approaches,
- construction of ROBs/RUBs requires speed restrictions. It is not possible to impose speed restriction at many locations simultaneously to carry out the construction of ROBs/RUBs.
- (d) Zone-wise sanctioned Road Over Bridges/Road Under Bridges on cost sharing basis with State Governments are as under:-

(e) Pro-active Measures Taken by Railways for Expeditious

Construction of ROBs/RUBs:

Railways has taken pro-active measures in close coordination with various stakeholders to improve the progress of construction of ROBs/RUBs which are as under:

- engaging single agency for construction of Railway Bridge as well as the approaches.
- joint survey with all concerned including State Government to finalise the tentative General Arrangement Drawing (GAD).
- circulation of check list and guidelines for preparation of
 GAD to State Government to avoid any back reference
 from Railway to State Government.
- standardization of drawings for various spans to avoid delay in designing.
- nomination of nodal officer for each State for single window clearance of GAD from Railway side.
- use of pre-cast/pre-fabricated components of the bridge.
