FINANCIAL LOSS DUE TO DILAPIDATED ROADS

3689. SHRI RAVINDRA KUMAR PANDEY:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any survey has been conducted on the loss incurred due to roads in bad shape in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof State/UT-wise and details of the action taken by the Government to identify the roads which are in bad shape in the country and action taken in this regard;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to get a survey conducted by the apex institutes with regard to the delay in the construction of roads in the country and the position of the vehicles available and their condition in the country under public transport system; if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the condition of roads in the different States of the country including Jharkhand is poor and their number is inadequate and negligible in view of the demand of public transport passengers; and
- (e) if so, the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) to (c) No Madam. The state PWD every year submit the proposals for development and maintenance of National Highways which are in bad condition and Ministry sanction proposals depending upon the availability of funds and inter se priority.

(d) to (e) No Madam. Some of the National Highways in the country including Jharkhand are poor in condition for which proposals are being processed and will be implemented as early as possible.
