(a)to(c):Yes, Madam. As per the report received from Indian Coast Guard 40 Indian ships/vessels were caught in distress/ distress-like situation during the last three years and the current year due to grounding, collision, sunk, flooding, fire on board, engine failure etc. The respective Maritime Rescue Co-ordination Centre (MRCCs) had coordinated and necessary rescue measures under taken through various agencies.
