Will the Minister of **DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION** be pleased to state:

- (a) the items of work undertaken in Jharkhand under Swachh Bharat Mission Gramin, (SBM—G);
- (b) the number of people who have beenbenefited under SBM—G in the State; and
- (c) the items of works which have notbeen undertaken under SBM—G till nowand the time by which these items of worksare likely to be completed in the State?

- (a) Under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) (SBM(G)), 7,21,036 Individual household latrines (IHHLs) have been constructed in Jharkhand from 2.10.2014 to 5.12.2016 as per the information uploaded by the State on the online Integrated Management Information System (IMIS) of SBM(G). In addition, 43 community toilets have been constructed in this period. Many villages have also taken up works pertaining to solid and liquid waste management. 1456 villages have declared themselves as free from open defecation.
- (b) As mentioned above, 7,21,036 households have gained access to toilet under SBM(G). All the members of these households have thus benefited.
- (c) As on 5.12.2016, 28,42,667 households are still without toilets in Jharkhand as per the IMIS of SBM(G). The likely date for completion for this work is 2.10.2019.
