(a) & (b) The Government of India has established National Water Mission (NWM) under National Action Plan on Climate Change with the objective of “conservation of water, minimizing wastage and ensuring its more equitable distribution both across and within States through integrated water resources development and management”. For FY: 2016-17 the total budgetary allocation to NWM is Rs. 25.00 crore. The expenditure towards activities for which budget allocation has been made to NWM is given in **Annexure**. The activities of NWM are now being integrated with the regular programmes of the Ministry.
