(a): The objective to set up the Central Medical Services Society (CMSS) was to have in place an independent, professional and autonomous agency for central procurement of quality health sector goods and services required by the Department of Health and Family Welfare in a transparent, fair & efficient manner at competitive rates and to maintain the uninterrupted supply of medicines/drugs through an IT enabled system.
