(a) & (b): As on date, there are no Unit / Factory under Ordnance Factory Board (OFB) which is complete in all respect but yet to start functioning.

Ordnance Factory located at Nalanda mandated for production of Bi-Modular Charge System (BMCS) has already started production since 2015-16. Nitro Cellulose (NC) Plant and Sulphuric Acid Concentration / Nitric Acid Concentration (SAC/NAC) Plant have been commissioned and 5 BMCS Plants are under procurement.
