4008. SHRI RAMDAS C. TADAS: SHRI SUKHBIR SINGH JAUNAPURIA: SHRI KONDA VISHWESHWAR REDDY:

Will the Minister of AYURVEDA, YOGA AND NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (AYUSH) be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to set up yoga universities across the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State/UTwise including Maharashtra and Rajasthan;
- (c) the time by which the said universities are likely to be established;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to use AYUSH therapies, particularly yoga, as an instrument for deaddiction and rehabilitation of drugs users in de-addiction centres; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYURVEDA, YOGA & NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (SHRI SHRIPAD YESSO NAIK)

- (a): There is no proposal with the Central Government to set up any Yoga University.
- (b) & (c): Does not arise.
- (d) & (e): The different techniques of Yoga are widely used for de-addiction and rehabilitation of drugs users in de-addiction centres. The practices used are mainly the Shatkriyas, Asanas, Pranayamas and Meditation.

However, Ministry of AYUSH has not set up specific de-addiction centres or formulated any guidelines in regard to de-addiction centres.
