Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any plan for the ASHA certification programme in the country in the year 2015-17;
- (b) whether the Government has identified the States for the programme; and
- (c) if so, the details of funds provided for the same?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)

- (a) & (b): The Government of India is providing support to States for implementation ASHA Certification Programme under National Health Mission (NHM). In the first phase, twelve states are being covered, namely, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Chhattisgarh, Delhi, Gujarat, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Punjab, Sikkim, Tripura, Uttrakhand and West Bengal.
- (c): Under NHM support is being provided to States including support for ASHA Certification on the basis of requirement posed by them in their annual Programme Implementation Plans (PIPs). Details of amount approved for the twelve states during FY 2013-14 to 2015-16 for ASHA Certification under NHM is at Annexure.
