### SHORTAGE OF PHYSIOTHERAPISTS IN HOSPITALS

## 4087. PROF. RAVINDRA VISHWANATH GAIKWAD:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of sanctioned post of various grades of Physiotherapists in various Central Government hospitals in the country;
- (b) whether there is a shortage of Physiotherapists in the hospitals across the country and if so, the details thereof, hospital-wise; and
- (c) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to fulfil the said shortage?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)

(a) to (c):- As far as three Central Government Hospitals in Delhi i.e. Safdarjung Hospital, Dr. RML Hospital and Lady Hardinge Medical College & Associated Hospitals are concerned, the details of vacant posts of Physiotherapists in these Hospitals is as under:
