- (a) No authoritative information regarding India's share in the global import of weapons is available. However, as per report published in February, 2016 by the Stockholm International Peace Research Institute (SIPRI), India's share in international arms imports during 2011-2015 was 14%.
- (b) to (d): The expenditure on Capital acquisition from foreign vendors and percentage of such expenditure to the total expenditure on Capital acquisition during each of the last three years is as under:-
