- (a) whether the Government is aware that trade unions have called for an increase in the minimum personal income tax exemption limit to Rs. 5 lakh during their pre-budget consultative meeting;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the trade unions have also demanded that pension for workers be increased from Rs. 1000 and Rs. 3000 and be given to all kind of workers; and
- (d) if so, the reaction of the Government thereon?

ANSWER
