- (a) the funds allocated and released in the form of central assistance to the States/ UTs including Maharashtra under the Industrial Infrastructure Upgradation Scheme (IIUS) during the last three years along with the total funds released to the States;
- (b) the details of assistance provided to Aurangabad district of Maharashtra for development of export infrastructure and related activities along with the outcome thereof;
- (c) whether any efforts have been made to set-up any industry based on raw resources available in Aurangabad district of Maharashtra; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a): The details of funds allocated and released in the form of central assistance to the States/UTs including Maharashtra during the last three years under Industrial Infrastructure Upgradation Scheme (IIUS)/Modified IIUS (MIIUS) of this Department are given below:

(b): Department of Commerce was administering a Centrally Sponsored Scheme started since 2002-03 i.e. "Assistance to States for Infrastructure Development of Exports" (ASIDE) Scheme with the objective to involve the States in the export effort by providing assistance to the State Governments for creating appropriate infrastructure for the development and growth of exports.

The Scheme has been delinked for support from the Centre since 2015-16. The details of funds released to Maharashtra under State Component of ASIDE Scheme during the last three years for creation of export infrastructure are given below:

(c) & (d): There is no specific scheme in the Department for intervention at district level. Assistance is provided for upgradation of infrastructure in industrial clusters based on the proposals received from the State Implementing Agency (in case of MIIUS) and SPVs (in case of IIUS).
