(a) & (b): Yes, Madam. The implementation of Sustainable Tourism Criteria for India (STCI) was launched by the Ministry of Tourism in association with Ecotourism Society of India (ESOI) in the month of October 2016. The criteria aims to fully implement sustainable tourism practices, consistent with the best environment and heritage protection standards, such that the present tourism resource requirements optimize both local community benefits and future sustainable uses.
