(a) & (b): MHRD through the University Grants Commission (UGC) is implementing three schemes namely Community Colleges, B. Voc degree programme and Deen Dayal Upadhyay KAUSHAL Kendras for skill development based vocational courses throughout the country. UGC has already approved Universities/Institutes for running 200 Community Colleges, 162 B. Voc degree Programme and 64 Deen Dayal Upadhyay KAUSHAL Kendras.
