**UNDP ASSISTANCE FOR PROMOTION OF RURAL TOURISM**

- (a) the quantum of funds that have been sanctioned under the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) for Kerala with regards to protection of rural tourism;**
- (b) the details of such sites/projects in Kerala; and**
- (c) the achievements made so far and the future plans under UNDP assistance in the State?**

**(a) to (b): The Endogenous Tourism Project - Rural Tourism Scheme (ETP-RTS) was a collaborative effort between the Ministry of Tourism, Government of India and United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) initiated in 2003. UNDP provided software support to the amount of Rs.20.00 Lakh per Rural Tourism Village site.**

**In December, 2005 the Ministry of Tourism revised the 'Capacity Building for Service Providers Scheme' to include Capacity Building 'Software Support' up to Rs. 20.00 Lakh per Rural Tourism Village site.**

**The details of such sites/projects sanctioned under UNDP Endogenous Tourism Project -Rural Tourism Scheme (ETP-RTS) in Kerala are as follows:-**
