Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken note that majority of the students who joined the IITs in the current year are from urban areas of the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard;
- (c) whether the Government has any proposal to frame a uniform syllabus for all students from class Tenth to class Twelfth in the country; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the time by which it is likely to be implemented?

Out of 10476 candidates admitted in IITs as per JEE(Advanced) 2016, 7857 (75%) candidates appeared in class XII from urban areas whereas the remaining 2619 (25%) were from rural areas. Steps are being taken by the school education department in conjunction with the State Governments for improving the standards of education in the remote rural areas.
