(a) to (d): Government of India for promoting manufacturing and Industrial Development in the country is developing following industrial corridors:

- (i) Delhi Mumbai Industrial Corridor (DMIC).
- (ii) Chennai Bengaluru Industrial Corridor(CBIC)
- (iii) Bengaluru-Mumbai Economic Corridor(BMEC)
- (iv) Amritsar Kolkata Industrial Corridor(AKIC)
- (v) Vizag Chennai Industrial Corridor(VCIC)

The Industrial Corridors are envisaged to provide world class infrastructure. Industrial Cities/Integrated Manufacturing Clusters(IMCs) across the corridors are planned for development on the land provided by State Government near the Railway's Dedicated Freight Corridors(DFCs), National/ State Highways, Railway and coastal lines.
