Shortage of Staff in IIAS

4363. SHRI VIRENDER KASHYAP:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that Indian Institute of Advanced studies (IIAS), Shimla is running short of its working people and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the institute is suffering due to shortage of staff;
- (c) whether there is any policy adopted by the Government to fill up the vacancies and the policy for the regularisation of contractual staff; and
- (d) the details of various activities going on in the said institute?

ANSWER

- (a) & (b): Out of 124 sanctioned posts in Indian Institute of Advanced Study (IIAS), Shimla, 84 posts are presently occupied.
- (c): IIAS, Shimla is an autonomous organisation, which fills up its vacancies as per its recruitment rules. There is no policy of the Government for the regularisation of contractual staff.
- (d): IIAS, Shimla is governed as per its Memorandum of Association (MoA) and its activities are mentioned therein. The main activities are as follows:
 - (i) Offering fellowship in the field of humanities and social sciences.
 - (ii) Organizing and conducting conferences, seminars, symposia and schools on various themes.
 - (iii) Inviting research scholars to deliver lectures or conduct research.
 - (iv) Providing financial assistance for advanced study for teachers and other scholars.
 - (v) Selective publishing of periodicals, monographs, books etc. for the development of its objectives.
