**Intermediate Education in Kasturba Gandhi Girls Vidyalaya**

4364. SHRI Y.S AVINASH REDDY:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government is planning to introduce Intermediate Education in Kasturba Gandhi Girls Vidyalayas (KGGVs) throughout the country, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has received any representation from various State Governments including Andhra Pradesh with regard to sanction of funds for starting Intermediate Education in KGGV schools and if so, the details thereof; State/UT-wise;
- (c) the response of the Government to the request and the quantum of funds being allocated for this purpose, State-wise; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a): No Madam, as per existing Kasturba Gandhi Girls Vidyalayas (KGBVs) financial norms, which is a part of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) there is no provision for Intermediate Education.

(b): Madam, No representation has been received from State Government of Andhra Pradesh for expanding the Kasturba Gandhi Girls Vidyalaya (KGGV) scheme to include intermediate education. Only one representation has been received from the State Government of Telangana for expanding the Kasturba Gandhi Girls Vidyalaya (KGGV) scheme to include intermediate education. However, no other details have been received along with the representation.

(c) & (d): The request cannot be agreed to as per the existing norms under the Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya (KGBV) scheme.
