WATER NEAR RAILWAY UNDER-BRIDGES

†4394. SHRI NAGAR RODMAL:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has collected information with regard to such railway under bridges where water and mud continues to persist even after the rainy season;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the details of the alternative measures taken to ensure smooth movement through such under bridges?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

(a) to (d): Presently, there is no reported case of water logging in Road Under Bridges (RUBs) after the rainy season.

However, while constructing Road Under Bridges (RUBs), drainage work is planned and provided as warranted by the local conditions. Furthermore, undertaking is taken from the State Government for maintenance of drainage system, road and lighting while constructing Road Under Bridges (RUBs). Complaints received regarding water logging are referred to State Governments for necessary action.
