CONSTRUCTION OF RAILWAY OVER BRIDGES

†4436. SHRI RAHUL KASWAN:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received representations regarding construction of railway over bridges at Sujangarh, Ratangarh, Churu and Ladulpur stations' railway crossings under the north western railways;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether approval has been given for construction of over-bridges at the said locations; and
- (d) if so, the time by which the construction of over bridges is likely to be started at the said places?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): No representation has been received for construction of Road Over Bridges (ROBs) in lieu of level crossings at Sujangarh, Ratangarh, Churu and Ladulpur stations' railway crossings in the recent past.

However, a representation was received from Hon'ble Member of Parliament for construction of Road Over Bridge (ROB) in lieu of Level Crossing (LC) No. 142 near Sadulpur Railway Station. This LC falls on National Highway. Therefore, the same is to be constructed by NHAI (National Highway Authority of India), as per Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) signed on 10.11.2014 between Ministry of Railways and Ministry of Road Transport & Highways (MORTH). MORTH has to submit General Arrangement Drawing (GAD) for approval from concerned Railway.
