STOPPAGE AT METRO STATIONS

(a) whether the Railways plan to stop trains at all the metro railway stations in India to control the city traffic at the main railway stations; and

(b) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b): Provision of stoppages over Indian Railways is an ongoing process depending upon the factors like traffic offering at the stations, operational feasibility, commercial viability, availability of alternative services, passing time of the train at the station, pattern of services, population and significance of towns/cities and new developments taking place etc.
