(a) to (c) Directorate General of Training, Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship, has formulated two schemes titled "Skill Development in 47 Districts Affected by Left Wing Extremism" and "Enhancing Skill Development Infrastructure in NE States & Sikkim" to establish 69 new Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs). An amount of Rs.295 crore with 75% central and 25% State share under the scheme "Skill Development in 47 Districts Affected by Left Wing Extremism" and Rs. 209 core with 90% central and 10% State share under the scheme "Enhancing Skill Development Infrastructure in NE States & Sikkim" have been allocated for the purpose. The scheme wise details may be seen at **Annexure-I**.
