4556. SHRI B.N. CHANDRAPPA: SHRI D.K. SURESH:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Railways has installed CCTV cameras in coaches of passenger and sub-urban trains on a pilot basis;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Railways proposes to seek feedback from the train commuters about the implementation of the new initiative in the system; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the further steps the Railways proposes to take in this regard?

- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam. The Government has installed CCTV cameras on a limited number of coaches of passenger and suburban trains on a pilot basis. Sanction for provision of CCTV cameras in 500 coaches has been obtained under the Rolling Stock Programme 2015-16. Work has already been completed in about 25 passenger coaches and 32 suburban coaches that have been commissioned in service.
