RESERVATION ROSTER IN AIR/DD

4581: PROF. PREM SINGH CHANDUMAJRA:

Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a reservation roster for SC and ST has not been maintained in AIR and DD and if so, the details and the reasons thereof;
- (b) whether officers appointed through the UPSC have retired without getting promotion after rendering service of 30 to 32 years and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether any responsibility has been fixed in this regard and if so, the details thereof, and
- (d) whether the Government proposes to implement the reservation roster as per rules immediately and fulfil the backlog vacancies in the said departments?

The MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING [COL RAJYAVARDHAN RATHORE (Retd.)]

- (a) Prasar Bharati has informed that Reservation Rosters are being maintained in respect of all cadres in All India Radio (AIR) and Doordarshan (DD) as per DOPT guidelines issued from time to time.
- (b) Departmental Promotion Committees (DPCs) could not be constituted in time in some cases due to litigation and also due to non-acceptance of proposals for promotion in respect of Prasar Bharati [PB] employees by Union Public Service Commission [UPSC] on account of amendment to Prasar Bharati (Broadcasting Corporation of India) Act. The matter has now been resolved and PB is conducting the DPCs.
- (c) Does not arise in view of (b) above.
- (d) Filling up the vacant posts is an ongoing process. Vacancies including backlog vacancies, if any are filled from the eligible persons as per the guidelines issued in this regard.
