DIGITIZATION OF LITERARY WORKS

4600. SHRI D.K. SURESH:

Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has maintained the record of all the books and literary works edited and published by various Indian and Foreign scholars during pre-Independence era; and
- (b) whether the Government has taken any steps to digitize all the ancient books and literary works listed till date and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

- (a) Yes, Sir. The National Library of India under Ministry of Culture has record of major books and literary works edited and published by various Indian and foreign scholars during pre-Independence era. In 1867, the Government of India passed an Act, namely, Press & Registration of Books Act. Under this Act Kolkata Public Library used to receive a copy of all the books published. Most of the catalogues of books published by Imperial Library are available in the National Library, Kolkata.
- (b) The National Library of India has already taken up a project of digitization of old and rare Indian books published prior to 1930.
