Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Watershed Development Component to Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (WDC-PMKSY) has been implemented in Sagar district of Madhya Pradesh;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of the works undertaken and completed under the said scheme in the said district?

(a) to (c): In Sagar district of Madhya Pradesh, 26 watershed development projects covering an area of about 1.7 lakh hectare to be implemented at a total cost of Rs. 205.18 crore were sanctioned during 2009-10 to 2014-15 under the erstwhile Integrated Watershed Management Programme (IWMP), which has been amalgamated as the Watershed Development Component of the Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (WDC-PMKSY) in 2015-16.

These projects are at various stages of implementation. The activities undertaken under these projects *inter alia* include ridge area treatment, drainage line treatment, soil and moisture conservation, rain water harvesting, nursery raising, afforestation, horticulture, pasture development, livelihoods for assetless persons, etc.
