CONNECTIVITY OF DAUSA TO SWAI MADHOPUR ROAD TO NH

4722. SHRI SUKHBIR SINGH JAUNAPURIA:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government proposes to connect Road from Dausa to Swai Madhopur to National Highway (NH);
(b) if so, the details thereof and whether the Government proposes to expand this road to two lanes, if so, the details thereof;
(c) whether the Government has enhanced the budgetary allocation for construction of fly-overs; and
(d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) and (b) Dausa-Sawai Madhopur is already connected by National Highway (NH) network via Lalsot, Kothum, Tonk through NH Nos. 148, 23, 52 and 552.

The work of widening to four lane of NH-148 stretch from Dausa to Lalsot and widening to 2 lane with paved shoulders of NH-23 stretch from Lalsot to Kothum have been awarded in July, 2016 with completion period of 30 months from the date of commencement.

NH-52 stretch from Kothum to Tonk is already 4 lane Highway.

The work of widening to 2 lane with paved shoulder of NH-552 stretch from Tonk to Sawai Madhopur has been awarded in August, 2016 with completion period of 24 months from the date of commencement.

Further, the Ministry has approved "In-Principle" the declaration of stretch of State road connecting Lalsot with Sawai Madhopur as new NH subject to the outcome of Detailed Project Report (DPR); initiatives have been taken up also for preparation of DPR.

(c) and (d) The Ministry does not allocate funds separately for construction of flyovers on NHs. The budget allocation for Central Road Sector (Plan) during 2016-17 (at first Supplementary stage) is as under:-
