# ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE FOR DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION (SHRI RAMESH CHANDAPPA JIGAJINAGI)

(a)&(b). Yes Madam. The State of Uttarakhand has submitted a project proposal (Uttarakhand Rural Water Supply & Sanitation Project-II) costing Rs. 1800 crore with an external assistance of Rs. 1613.28 crore form World Bank. The Ministry has recommended the project proposal to Department of Economic Affairs (DEA) and the same has been posed to World Bank by DEA on 23.03.2015.
