(a)&(b). Yes Madam. The State of Uttarakhand has submitted a project proposal (Uttarakhand Rural Water Supply & Sanitation Project-II) costing Rs. 1800 crore with an external assistance of Rs. 1613.28 crore from World Bank. The Ministry has recommended the project proposal to Department of Economic Affairs (DEA) and the same has been posed to World Bank by DEA on 23.03.2015.
