DELHI-MEERUT EXPRESS HIGHWAY PROJECT

4760. SHRIMATI VEENA DEVI:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the construction of Delhi-Meerut expressway project has been given approval by the Government;
- (b) if so, the facts in this regard including the date on which it was approved;
- (c) whether a time-limit has been fixed to complete the construction work of the said project; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof including the status of the construction till date?

(a)& (b) Delhi-Meerut Expressway is to be constructed in four packages, out of which three packages i.e. (i) Nizamuddin Bridge to UP Border (ii) UP Border to Dasna (iii) Dasna to Hapur have already been approved on 19-11-2015, 12-05-2016 and 01-12-2015 respectively. For the fourth package i.e. New Alignment of Delhi Meerut Expressway from Dasna to Meerut, appraisal and approval is to be accorded and bids have already been invited.

(c)& (d) Pre-construction activities are under progress and appointed date of one package i.e. Nizamuddin Bridge to UP Border has been declared on 28th November, 2016. The completion period of these packages is 2.5 years from the appointed date.
