Will the Minister of SHIPPING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether some of the major ports in the country particularly Kamarajar Port Limited propose to implement Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) system to track the movement of men, materials and vehicles within the port premises on real time basis;
- (b) if so, the details and the present status thereof, port-wise;
- (c) the extent to which the implementation of RFID is likely to be advantageous in terms of time and cost reduction; and
- (d) the timeframe set for implementation of RFID, port-wise?

ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING (SHRI PON. RADHAKRISHNAN)

(a)&(b): Yes, Madam. Present status of RFID system (Port-wise) is at Annexure.

- (c) Implementation of RFID system will eliminate manual checking of documents at port gate and real time tracking of movement of vehicles, men & materials. This would reduce congestion and also cost of operations at Ports.
- (d) All Major Ports have been directed to implement RFID system by 31.03.2017.
